

## **Information on the use of the Ohio Sport Fish Consumption Advisories Interactive Map**

### Advisory Information

#### **How do I view a stream segment or lake that has an advisory?**

Click on the box next to an advisory and there will be a zoom view of the advisory.

#### **How do I see information regarding the advisory?**

Once zoomed in, click on the specific stream segment or lake and an information box will pop up.

#### **What do the different colors for the stream segments mean (blue, green and red)?**

Stream segments that are beside each other have different colors so they can be distinguished from each other. Other than that, the different colors have no special significance.

### Navigating the Map

#### **How do I return to the statewide view?**

Click on “hand” in the pan tool in the upper left corner of the map and you will return to the statewide view. Alternatively, you can uncheck and recheck the selection at the bottom of the list of advisories that is listed as “Initial View” – this will also return you to the statewide view.

#### **What if it is slow navigating around the map?**

If you are using Internet Explorer, consider using another Web browser. Browsers such as Firefox <http://www.mozilla.com> and Google Chrome <http://www.google.com/chrome> are considerably faster.

#### **What kind of views can I see in the map?**

Four different views, located in the upper right corner of the map, are available.

- “Map view” – Map with roads and cities identified
- “Terrain view” – Map that also shows the topography of the area
- “Satellite view” – Satellite view of the area
- “Hybrid view” – Satellite view with roads and cities identified

#### **How do I zoom in or out on the map?**

Use the zoom tool in the upper left corner of the map. Or double click on the map to zoom in.

#### **How do I scroll around or pan the map?**

Use the pan tool in the upper left corner of the map. Or hold your main mouse button down and move the mouse.

#### **Can I see more than one advisory at a time?**

Yes. Simply check additional boxes. You may need to zoom out to see all the checked advisories at one time.
